This Outspan captures the atmosphere of a bygone era. In the days of the transport riders, the area where the town of Sabie is today was a popular place to outspan the oxen from the fully laden ox wagons, while the parties took their rest, socialised or concluded their business. The Sabie area was cool, malaria free and had an abundance of game, which was hunted for trophies, sport, hides, and of course for the pot. It was also a social time for everyone.



One of these transport riders was Percy Fitzpatrick who—with his now famous dog, Jock—frequently travelled through the area. His route passed through Sabie, 50 metres from where you are now sitting.

Downstairs, the history of Sabie and the area is portrayed on large laminated posters and through photographs of the period. Books of Jock of the Bushveld, Jock route maps, and other related literature are available for sale at the reception desk.

A quaint retreat, The Loft Coffee Shoppe, panelled in Knotty Pine, a unique escape!







Rooibos occurs naturally in the mountains of the Cedarberg region near Clanwilliam in the Western Cape Province.

Rooibos teas are caffeine free, low in tannins and rich in anti-oxidants. Flavours include *Natural*, *Honey Bush*, *Lemon Grass*, *Chamomile* and *Fennel*. With the exception of *Fennel*, all flavours are from organically grown, steam-sterilized tea.

- Imported Teas
We serve regular Five Roses tea, as well as a number of Twinings flavours such as *Earl Grey*, *English Breakfast*, *Prince of Wales* and *Green Tea (Mint)*.




